

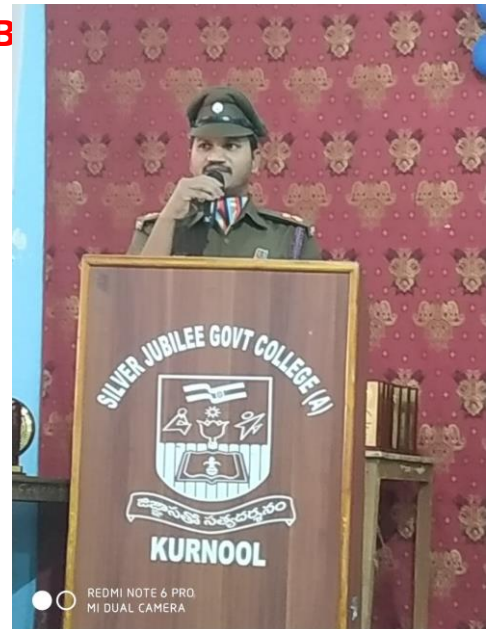



- On the occasion of 20th anniversary of Kargil war which took place in 1999, NCC Unit 142/28 Coy , NCC Silver Jubilee Govt.
