## **NCC AT SJGC:**

142/28 Coy was raised in 1972. It has 200 cadet strength under the unit of 28<sup>th</sup> Andhra Battalion which is located in Kurnool Head Quarters.

58/9 G Coy was raised in 2019 with the strength of 100 cadets after the co-education was introduced in the college. The coy is under the control of 9 Andhra Battalion which is also located in the same town. The college remains grateful to the both units for providing such a wonderful opportunity for 300 students who come through the entrance examinations at state level.

NCC course is run with two certificate courses 'B' & 'C' for the undergraduates. Initially the enrollment takes place after the admissions are completed in first year on proportionate of 33% of the total strength. The college, as per schedule, organise, train and motivate the cadets to develop leadership qualities in every sphere of life. During the training our cadets are trained in drill, shooting, physical fitness and map reading.

# INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING

## INTRODUCTION

Institutional Training being conducted in the Colleges and Schools is the principal means of training in the NCC. The aim of the training is to nurture core values, enhance awareness and give exposure to basic military skills and knowledge.

Emphasis will be on practical training. Case studies, wherever possible will be used to facilitate active participation and better assimilation. Examples from India's freedom struggle and wars Fought by India, post-independence, should supplement relevant subjects to generate secular and patriotic fervor. The instructors and the cadets must grasp the importance of this training and participate actively.

## CATC:

The aim of Annual Training Camps is to impart collective training to cadets with special emphasis on the development of qualities of leadership **Combined annual training camp(CATC)/Annual training camp(ATC)** are held within the state. Basically these **camps** have a duration of 10 days.

- Firing practice.
- Cultural competition.
- Obstacles practice.
- Lectures regarding hygiene and health.

Combined annual training camps were organised by Kurnool NCC Group HQ Kurnool May 2019 to January 2020. Altogether 600 cadets for across the two districts took part in every CATC.

The NCC cadets have participated in various educational and welfare programmes such as Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, ill effects of drugs, anti-malaria drive, etc They also assisted in traffic control during major events viz marathon, Independence Day and Republic Day parades among others.

The cadets were also exposed to many competitions like debates, lectures to improve their communication skills.
