

GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH SEED MONEY

Dr: 20/01/2020

(1) As per the NAAC Guidelines in Criterion - III - Research, Innovation and extension (3.1) Promotion of Research and Facilities it is essential for the Institute to provide the Seed money to the faculty and students to conduct research.

(2) In this regard, Governing body meeting -10, held on 14-12-2019 at SGC, item 15. It is resolved and approved by Commissioner of Collegiate Education to utilize SET balance amount available towards research activities for students by converting to "Research Seed Account."

(3) To utilize Research Seed Account a Committee is constituted with following members:

- (7) Dept of Computer Science - Sri. G. Polkurajee

The following are the Guidelines for utilizing Research Seed Account amount:

- (a) To carryout Student study projects
- (b) To participate in Workshops / Seminars / Symposia / Conferences for presenting Paper / poster
- (c) To conduct field project works
- (d) To participate in Student Exchange programmes as part of collaborations and MoU
- (e) For Initiating MoU / collaborations from Institute / Institution by Faculty while requesting for the money the PI of the project should submit a detailed project proposal with tentative expenditure. The Committee will approve the project and an advance will be released to the PI and after settlement of final bills the total amount will be released to PI (Principal Investigator)

The fund money will be utilized to meet the expenditure towards registration, accommodation, food, travel and other expenses for attending to Seminars / Conferences by students and faculty.




